二、各档次的给分范围和要求

第三档：（8-12 分）能写出基本要点；语言虽有较多错误，尚能达意。

第二档：（4-7 分）能写出部分要点；语言错误多，影响意思表达。

第一档：（0-3 分）白卷，或文不对题，或错误百出，不知所云。

A possible student text:
